RULES & REGULATION

Boaters are required to observe and comply with the following rules and regulations:-

1. A berthing place will be allocated to you upon your arrival at the marina.
2. Please observe "No-Wake" speed at all times in the marina basin. Guests are legally responsible for wake and the damage and personal injury it causes no matter how large or small the wake.
3. Pumping of oil, diesel or fuel waste and waste tank within the marina basin is strictly prohibited. Any boaters found guilty of this act will be charged for the cleaning of the mess. The incident will be reported to the Department of Environment whereby guests will be charged according to the statutory provisions.
4. All boats berthed must be kept in good order and working condition.
5. All boats berthed must be securely tied up and berthing ropes must be in good condition.
6. Fenders must be in use, while tied to the pontoon. No tyres are allowed.
7. NO fishing is allowed within the marina basin.
8. NO storage of boat equipment, storage boxes, jet skis, dinghy, etc, are allowed on the pontoon unless with the express consent of the marina management.
9. NO cooking is allowed on the pontoon.
10. Any excessive noise, music or prolonged engine testing is to be minimized.
11. Boat owners will be held responsible for their guests' and crew's action and/or inaction.
12. All refuses are to be properly bagged and disposed off at the nearest rubbish bin.
13. The swimming pool is for members and guests only. Crew are prohibited from this facility.
14. The running of generator is allowed only if it is non-polluting and is not a disturbance to others.
15. All boats are required to be fitted with an automatic bilge pump system.
16. The dress code that is in force within the Club premises must be abided by.

17. Shower and changing rooms are open 24 hours daily for your convenience. Please keep them clean.
18. In the interest of safety, privacy and security,
 - a. only boat owners, passengers and crew are allowed within the pontoon area.
 - b. guests have to be accompanied by boat owners.
 - c. guests of crew must have the express consent of the boat owners in order to be allowed into the marina area.
 - d. unaccompanied guests of boat owners' wishing to access the boat will NOT be allowed unless a letter of authority from the boat owners is provided or prior arrangements have been made by boat owners with the club management.
19. Contractors engaged by boat owners must be registered at the Security Department before entry. Boat owners are deemed responsible for any acts carried out by contractors engaged by him. All contractors acting on the boat owner's instruction must be made aware of these Rules and Regulation.
20. No deck sanding, spray painting or any other work that will cause pollution to the berthing area is allowed. If such work needs to be carried out, the boat has to be moved to the repair yard pontoon on the conditions that space is available and the prevailing charges is levied and settled in advance.
21. Boat owners will be charged for the cleaning and removal of any mess and/or debris left by their contractors on the pontoons or marina basin or club facility. The club may, at its sole discretion, collect debris disposal deposit as it deems fit.
22. The boat owner agrees that he is berthing the boat entirely at his own risk and acknowledges that the club is NOT responsible for any loss, and/or damages to the boat, its content or person.
23. All boats berthed at the marina are required to have their own insurance as provided under rule 41(2) of the Club Rules including third party coverage. The club reserves the right to refuse berthing to boats without the appropriate insurance.
24. The boat owner agrees that he is responsible for his passenger, guests' and crew's action or inaction and agrees to bear the cost of any damages to the berth, neighbouring boats and/or club property arising as a result of this action or inaction.
25. The management reserves the right to move any boats berthed at the marina to another berth for any reasons whatsoever as it deems fit.
26. All transactions are on cash terms and a deposit is required upon check-in.
27. Boaters who do not observe or comply with the above rules and regulation will be asked to leave the marina. The management reserves the right to refuse berthing for any boats for any reasons whatsoever and to change and amend these rules and regulations as and when deemed fit without prior notice.
